

### Language, Literacy & Communication

- To develop and use a wider range of vocabulary, including verbs and adjectives when talking and writing
- Begin to read back children's own writing
- Develop the ability to read out loud, with expression
- To begin to read and write a growing range of high frequency words
- To continue to expand our knowledge of letters and sounds to write sentences with increased independence
- Using basic punctuation accurately, beginning with capital letters and full stop

### Mathematics & Numeracy

- Recite numbers up to 100 forwards and backwards and from different starting points
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Number sequences within 50
- Identify 1 and 2 more/less and 10 more/less
- Place value using coins focusing on teen numbers (10p and 1ps)
- Ordering numbers within 50 from smallest to largest/ largest to smallest
- Bonds and number facts within 10/20
- Grouping and sharing
- Position and direction

### Learning through Play Activities

Opportunities will be created for children to engage in a wide range of activities through their play, celebration week and poignant events. These include, but are not limited to:

- Exploring the Royal Family and preparing for the king's coronation celebrations
- Exploring the 'age of the dinosaurs' including a trip to Cardiff Museum
- Working collaborately to prepare for and hold a Disney Parade
- Exploring STEM (science, technology, engineering and maths) through a range of different challenges



### Welsh

The children will investigate Welsh language through daily Helpwr Heddiw sessions, through play, stories and incidental Welsh used in school.

### Suggested Learning for School

- Continue to read home reading books
- Practising reading and spelling high frequency words (sent home last half term)
- Continue incorporate maths into every day activities: counting in 2s, 5s and 10s; referring to time o'clock and half past; writing numbers to 20 (extending to 100)
- Set up a hedgehog house (following our visit form hedgehog rescue)
- Visit the local library to choose and borrow books of your choice
