

## Year 2

### Language, Literacy & Communication –

- Phonics via daily Read Write Inc sessions and guided reading sessions for children who have completed the RWI programme.
- Reinforce and apply knowledge of letter sounds and formation via play, stories, shared and independent writing
- ‘Drawing Club’ progressing to writing simple and more complex words, phrases, sentences and paragraphs with a focus on writing for different purposes and genres.
- Sharing and discussing class stories, linking them to their own experiences and developing comprehension skills.

### Mathematics & Numeracy

- Reciting numbers backwards and forwards and counting in 2’s, 5’s and 10’s from different starting points
- Partitioning 2- digit numbers and knowing the value of each digit
- Use mental recall of number facts to 10 to double and halve
- Recognise and understand odd and even numbers
- Adding and subtracting using both mental and written strategies.
- Time around the world – comparing night and day and looking at different time zones linking to o’clock and half past.

### Topic Journey/ Learning through Play Activities

\_Opportunities will be created for children to engage in a wide range of activities through their play. Alongside child-initiated play, we will also be providing opportunities for children to join in with activities based around our topic “What a Wonderful World”.

- During inter-faith week we will focus on different faiths and their celebrations.
- Creating models and artefacts linked to different cultures and countries.
- Exploring and experimenting with a wide range of ingredients to create dishes from around the world.
- Expanding our horizons and knowledge of the world, beginning with our locality and beyond.
- Caring for our wider school environment and wildlife, including via our forest school sessions.



### Welsh

The children will investigate Welsh language through daily Helpwr Heddiw sessions, through play, stories and incidental Welsh used in school.
