Uniform

The wearing of uniform:

- gives pupils a sense of identity.
- gives status to the school.
- encourages pupils to dress neatly and wear suitable clothing.

Please ensure your child wears:

- Long or short grey trousers, skirt or pinafore dress
- White/Red shirt or polo shirt
- Red sweatshirt or cardigan
- Black shoes. No high heels or slip on shoes. Trainer style shoes are permitted as long as they are black and have no bright logos. Brightly coloured trainers are not permitted.
- **Labelled clothing is essential. Children frequently mislay items which can be returned if they are labelled.**
- Children are not allowed to come into school wearing Jewellery except for a single pair of stud earrings. No bracelets, chains or rings are permitted. Children are allowed to wear watches.
