Nursery Autumn 1

Language, Literacy & Communication

Focus for this term will be upon listening and responding appropriately, and developing confidence to be able to join in with familiar songs and rhymes and traditional tales.

Seasonal songs to include: Little Red Tractor, Dingle Dangle Scarecrow, Big Red Combine Harvester, 1 Potato 2 Potato, I dig my Garden... etc

Stories to include: The Enormous Turnip, The Little Red Hen, Jack and the Beanstalk

Mathematics & Numeracy

Opportunities as they arise within play on noticing number, shape and pattern in everyday situations, e.g. in the playdoh, sand and cooking areas.

Using the language of comparing in all areas e.g. which sandcastle is bigger/smaller? Which playdoh snake is longer/shorter? Counting songs which include counting forwards and backwards e.g. 5 little ducks, 12345 once I caught a fish alive, Way up high in the apple tree etc.

Learning through Play Activities

Activities to support recognising the changing seasons – opportunities for children to engage with:

- Leaf collecting & comparing
- Harvesting vegetables
- Cooking with fruit and vegetables in a variety of ways
- Making bread
- Making pictures with leaves
- Exploring pumpkins
- Birthdays and seasonal celebrations
