To improve standards and provision in reading and writing



- To begin the Fresh Start programme in years 5 and 6
- To strengthen effective practices in GGR
- To improve handwriting
- To improve spelling
- Ensure opportunities for high level literacy lessons

To improve standards and provision in Mathematics and Numeracy

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- Improve consistency in provision for developing pupils' mental agility
- Strengthen staff knowledge re: 4 maths planning resources and how these can be used to support skill development & progression
- Enhance use of Mathletics/Mathseeds to reinforce number skills in school and at home
- Introduce termly assessment through STAR maths diagnostic analysis to feed into next step planning

To further develop links with the school community

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- Improve equity in the range of opportunities and experiences the school provides for pupils
- Provide focused support for families facing specific challenges e.g. linked to poverty, educational needs, personal skills
- Enhance use of the local community and amenities as a resource for pupils' learning and experience to support the school's curriculum
- Develop a new facility to support partnership working with parents through face-to-face engagement e.g. further development of the school's nascent PTA, provision of workshops, as a meeting space and for community use
- Maintain a clear focus on attendance and address the level of persistent absence
