

Language, Literacy & Communication –

1. Phonics via daily Read Write Inc sessions and guided reading sessions for children who have completed the RWI programme.
2. Reinforce and apply knowledge of letter sounds and formation via play, stories, shared and independent writing
3. 'Drawing Club' progressing to writing simple and more complex words, phrases, sentences and paragraphs with a focus on writing for different purposes and genres.
4. Sharing and discussing class stories, from different cultures and religions
5. To learn lines and perform as part of our concert

Mathematics & Numeracy

1. Reciting numbers backwards and forwards and counting in 2's, 5's and 10's from different starting points
2. Recognise and understand odd and even numbers
3. Use money up to £1
4. Sorting by varying criteria
5. Time around the world – comparing night and day and looking at different time zones linking to o'clock and half past.

Topic Journey/ Learning through Play Activities

Opportunities will be created for children to engage in a wide range of activities through their play. Alongside child-initiated play, we will also be providing opportunities for children to join in with activities based around our topic "What a Wonderful World" – this will be included in our Christmas concert this year.

1. We will be preparing for our concert by:
 1. Learning songs in different languages
 2. Getting in to character
 3. Making props and backdrops
 4. Learning about how Christmas is celebrated in different countries around the World



Welsh

The children will investigate Welsh language through daily Helpwr Heddiw sessions, through play, stories and incidental Welsh used in school.
