<u>Language</u>, <u>Literacy & Communication –</u> Focus for this first half term will be on developing confidence with meaningful mark-making, speaking and listening, enjoying and responding to stories. Activities will include:

- Dough Disco
- Story Dough
- Daily story times
- Circle times
- Explore letter sounds and begin blending them together to make words.
- Opportunities for mark-making across our classroom: mud painting, chalk writing, writing and telling stories through pictures, role-play, art, emerging writing when ready, singing songs and rhymes.

<u>Mathematics & Numeracy – Through stories</u>, play, games, technology and mental maths sessions children will explore numbers to ten and beyond, focusing on:

- Counting on and back through recitation as well as counting groups of items. Start at different points each time.
- Extending our counting beyond 20 as well as counting in 2s and 10s.
- Read and write numbers to ten (and beyond to 20) on a number stick. What come before and after / one more or one less.
- Adding and subtracting within 10 by adding one more or one less.
- Explore finger patterns.
- Combine two groups of items to find how many altogether
- Recognise and sort coins to 10p.

- Make nature art with what we find in our Forest School.
- Narrate a story on the Green Screen for our Christmas show
- Learn new Christmas songs, singing in English and Welsh.
- Make Christmas cards for our loved ones.

- Use our artistic skills to make a 2024 calendar.
- Continue to care for our pet hamster,
 Cow by feeding and cleaning him.

In Reception we will explore the foundations of Welsh in our everyday routines, including

- Amser snac Ga I... / Snack time, can I have...
- Faint ydy dy oed di? / How old are you?
- Pa liw ydy hwn? / What colour is it?
- Rhifau / Numbers

As well as these phrases we will explore Welsh Christmas songs like *Dymunwn Nadolig Llawen*.
