Language, Literacy & Communication –

Wk 1 – Comprehension, planning a class debate based on the class novel The Boy at the back of the Class.

Wk 2 – Debate – linked to the class novel. Emotion graph

Wk 3 – Punctuating - using exclamation marks, research facts about the author of the Boy At the Back of the Class.

Wk 4 – Plan a biography, Write a biography.

Mathematics & Numeracy

Wk 3 – Multiply a single digit number by 10, 20, 100. Multiply a 3 digit number by a 1 digit number using the grid method.

Wk 4 - Shape – 3d shapes looking at vertices, faces, edges. Triangles – looking at properties and different types, to include angles.

Wk 5- Worded problems.

Wk 6- Finding perimeter with larger numbers – 3 digit , adding in columns. Finding area by using multiplication – single digit.

Wk 7- Time – looking at calendars, timetables and solving problems.
