
Message from Aneurin Bevan School Nursing Service:

According to our records your child has not yet received 2 doses of Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccine. The routine MMR schedule is 2 doses (1st dose age 1 and 2nd dose age 3 years 4 months)

There is currently an outbreak of Measles in the Health Board area and your child's school has been identified as having a low uptake. This leaves the population vulnerable to serious preventable diseases.
