

Year 2 – Autumn Term

Language, Literacy & Communication

- Phonics via daily Read Write Inc sessions and guided reading sessions for children who have completed the RWI programme.
- Reinforce and apply knowledge of letter sounds and formation via play, stories, shared and independent writing.
- Use a 'writing journey' to progress our skills in writing simple and more complex words, phrases, sentences and paragraphs. We will write for different purposes and genres including a fact file and a postcard.

Mathematics & Numeracy

- Reciting numbers backwards and forwards and counting in 2's, 5's and 10's from different starting points
- Partitioning 2-digit numbers and knowing the value of each digit
- Read and write numbers to 100
- Use mental recall of number facts to 10 to double and halve
- Find small differences within 20 by using 'counting on' strategies
- Recognise and understand odd and even numbers
- Adding and subtracting using both mental and written strategies.
