Improve The Progress Pupils Make In Applying Their Numeracy Skills In New And More Challenging Contexts Across The Curriculum

- Recognise and develop opportunities for children to apply their mathematical skills across AOLES, addressing the current limitation where only specific skills, such as measurement, are consistently utilised
- Encourage pupils to use mathematical concepts independently across AOLES, promoting a sense of ownership over their learning process and reinforcing their understanding
- Create engaging and purposeful indoor and outdoor environments that integrate mathematics into everyday learning experiences
- Develop learners' critical thinking and problem- solving skills by embedding mathematical reasoning across the curriculum, ensuring that children see the relevance of mathematics in real-world contexts
